O Lord, Give Me Mastery Over Impatience

For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry... Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain. Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts: for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh... Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of the Lord, for an example of suffering affliction, and of patience. Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy. (Habakkuk 2:3 & James 5:7-11).

Examples of Impatience vs Appointed Time

Read and Reflect:

- Day 1:** The impatience of the Children of Israel in the wilderness (Exodus 32)
- Day 2:** The delay of the birth of Isaac (Genesis 16)
- Day 3:** The Lord delayed Lazarus deliverance (John 11)
- Day 4:** The impatience of King Saul (1 Samuel 13)
- Day 5:** Elijah prays for Rain (1 Kings 18)

Suggested Prayer Points for Mastery Over Impatience

1. Lord God, I know that impatience is the fruit of unbelief. Therefore, “help thou my unbelief”, Lord
2. O Lord, teach me to wait, so that your will and your will alone be done in all circumstances in my life
3. Lord, I repent for times that I have been ill-tempered with my co-disciples and loved ones because of impatience
4. O Lord may I never give up on you when you delay for you know what is best for me, in the name of Jesus
5. Lord may you grant me the patient-faith and trust of the prophet Habakkuk 3:17-18, in the name of Jesus
6. Lord God, I claim the patience of Job and Elijah; and may you perfect their faith in me in the name of Jesus
7. Lord God may the Holy Spirit always prompt me whenever I am being impatient, in Jesus name

8. Lord may this scripture be my portion, “I wait for the Lord, my soul doth wait, and in his word, do I hope”.
9. “My soul waiteth for the Lord more than they that watch for the morning”. Therefore, Lord, do remember me as I wait patiently daily on you for salvation.
10. Lord, as I wait patiently for you may you incline unto me and put a new song in my mouth, in the name of Jesus
11. Lord, may the spirit of impatience never drive me to charge ahead of you without your counsel, in Jesus name
12. Lord may my hastiness to satisfy people never cause me to disobey your word, in Jesus name
13. Lord may I never forsake a hard but godly **counsel** because of the spirit of impatience, in the name of Jesus.
14. Lord may I never be disgraced because of an impatient response or action on my part, in the name of Jesus
15. Lord, when and after I receive proper counsel, give me the patience for that counsel to take effect, in Jesus name
16. O Lord may your spirit subdue all the impatient tendencies in my life, in the name of Jesus
17. Lord God, renew my strength continually as I will always patiently wait on you, in Jesus name
18. Lord may I never make an impatient decision that could result in another man replacing me, in the name of Jesus
19. O Lord may any power causing impatience to rise in me be silenced permanently, in the name of Jesus
20. O Lord, deliver me from self-righteousness and critical spirits born out of impatience
21. Lord, as I learn to be patient with people, cause others to exercise patience with me too, in the name of Jesus
22. Lord God, deliver me from anxieties and worries due to my impatience in the name of Jesus
23. Lord God, birth in me self-control, temperance and longsuffering for your name sake, in the name of Jesus
24. Lord may the patience and meekness of our Lord Jesus come upon me now, in the name of Jesus.
25. Lord, when I pray may I always remember that delayed answer is never denial, in the name of Jesus
26. Lord may I always remember every vision, dream or prophesy is for an appointed time, in the name of Jesus
27. Lord, help me not to ever exert myself obtrusively with my co-disciples or family because of impatience
28. Lord, forgive me for manipulating and bamboozling people to go along with my plans due to my impatience
29. Lord, deliver me from my tendency to make rash short-sighted choices because your plans for me are always perfect and on time
30. Lord, have mercy on me, reverse or correct every bad situation that I have found myself in today due to my impatience, in the name of Jesus

Fasting without intentional prayers is starvation!!
