Suggested Prayer Points for Old Time Religion

24. Lord may we as your disciples always be a personal testimony from our own experience of who Christ is and what he only can do
25. Lord as our pastor teaches or preaches may the power of the Holy Spirit carry the message as a living reality to the listeners heart, in the name of Jesus
26. Lord God help us to be able to yield ourselves with our whole hearts to the leading of the Holy Spirit.
