Read and Reflect:

Day 1: Magnify the Lord as the Creator (Psalms 104)

Day 2: The Lord triumphs gloriously over His enemies (Exodus 15:1-21)

Day 3: The Magnificat and Hannah prayer of thanks (Luke 1:46-56 & 1 Samuel 2:1-11)

Day 4: King David magnifies the Lord (1 Chronicles 17:16-27)

Day 5: The Lord's mercy endures forever (Psalms 118)

O Come, Join the Old Saints to Magnify the Lord and Bless His Holy Name

1. The Psalmist says, in **Psalms 115:1** give all glory to the Lord for His mercy and truth
2. The sweet Psalmist of Israel declares in **Psalms 86:8-10**, “thou art great...thou art God alone” doing wonderful things
3. Rejoice in the Lord with prophet **Habakkuk 3:17-19**, although all might seem hopeless, but God is your strength
4. Blessed the name of the Lord God of **Daniel 2:19-20, 23-24**: He gives wisdom and might and reveals deep secrets
5. King David leaps and dances before the Lord **2 Samuel 6:16, 20-22** to the scorn of his wife Michal
6. Apostle Peter gives glory to God **Acts 3:11-13** for the first apostolic miracle: a man lamed for 40 years walks
7. The Lord made Sarah “to laugh” at the birth of Isaac **Genesis 21:1-3, 6-7** after almost a hundred years of bareness
8. Trust in the Lord, the God of Shadrach-Meshach-Abednego **Daniel 3:16-18, 21-25** for honoring their reckless faith
9. Bless the Lord, for young David: great example of not fearing and confronting the enemy **1 Samuel 17:44-46**
10. **Jonah 2:1-4** cries out by reason of his affliction “out of the belly of hell”, the Lord heard and had mercy on him
11. Lord I follow the example of Paul **1 Corinthians 15:9-10** to glorify you for your “grace bestowed upon me”

12. Blessed be the God of Jacob [Genesis 28:13-15](#) who is faithful and gracious to fulfill His promises
13. O my soul, bless the Lord for the power of his Word to expose sins and convict sinners [Acts 2:37](#) among us
14. Lord you awed king Darius to decree that all nations should tremble and fear the God of [Daniel 6:25-27](#)
15. Bless the Lord O my soul, for “He openeth the ears of men, [Job 33:16](#) and sealeth their instruction”
16. O Lord my heart joins Deborah [Judges 5:1-3](#) to sing praises unto you continually for my avenger
17. [Psalms 8:3-5](#) “When I consider thy heavens, the works of thy fingers...what is man that thou art mindful of him?”
18. David’s thanksgiving and prayer [1 Chronicles 29:14](#) applauds that all we can ever give to you comes from you
19. O Lord, “I will praise thee: though thou wast angry with me, thine anger is turned away” [Isaiah 12:1](#)
20. The Lord JEHOVA is my strength, with joy shall I draw glad tidings from His “well of Salvation” [Isaiah 12:2-3](#)
21. Lord God you alone are worthy to be sanctified, feared and dreaded [Isaiah 8:13](#)
22. O Lord, I thank you, for there is no restraint to the Lord to save by many or by few [1 Samuel 14:6](#)
23. Blessed be my Redeemer that teaches me to prosper and leads me by the way I should go [Isaiah 48:17](#)
24. Bless the Lord God, for his compassion for Hezekiah; he heard his prayer and wiped away his tears [Isaiah 38:3-5](#)
25. Lord, I thank you for Father Abraham who “staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief” [Romans 4:20](#)
26. Bless the Lord O my soul, for the power to “call those things which be not as though they were” [Romans 4:17](#)
27. Lord, in this will I be confident, you’re always with me when I walk through murky waters and fire [Isaiah 43:1-2](#)
28. Lord, thank you for the diversities of spiritual gifts given to each man [1 Corinthians 12:4-7](#)
29. Bless the Lord, O my soul, for the Lord has given me power to tread on that old serpent [Luke 10:19](#)
30. Bless the Lord, O my soul, for He “Healeth all thy diseases...and makes thee whole” [Psalms 103:3](#)
31. Let’s Bless the Lord, He has not dealt with us nor rewarded us according to our sins or iniquities [Psalms 103:8-10](#)
32. Bless the Lord: from heaven He hears our groanings to ‘loose’ us from Satanic oppressions [Psalms 102:19-20](#)
33. O Lord, I glorify you for the power in your blood that purges my conscience from dead works [Hebrews 10:13-14](#)
34. Magnify the Lord: He is not unrighteous to forget the labor of love which you show towards Him [Hebrews 6:10](#)
35. Praise God: An apostle opened his mouth, and declared, that God is no respecter of persons [Acts 10:34 & Rom 2:29](#)
36. I will bless the Lord at all times, for he is sovereign, powerful and all knowing. He knows the end of all things from the beginning [Isaiah 46:9-10](#) Halleluiah, Praise ye the Lord. Amen and Amen
