- Day 5: Elisha prophesied the end of the famine (2 Kings 7)
- Day 6: Moses spoke against Korah and all his company's rebellion (Numbers 16)
- Day 7: Elisha decreed a son to the Shunammite woman (2 Kings 4:1-37)

- 1. Buy the truth, and sell it not; also, wisdom, and instruction, and understanding. (Proverbs 23:23)
- 2. For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that he hateth putting away: for one covereth violence with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts: therefore, take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not treacherously. (Malachi 2:16)
- 3. Sanctify ye a fast, call a solemn assembly, gather the elders and all the inhabitants of the land into the house of the LORD your God, and cry unto the LORD (Joel 1:14)
- 4. And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding (Jeremiah 3:15)
- 5. And he said, "Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked shall I return. The LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD (Job 1:21)
- 6. And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted (Rev 2:3)
- 7. Every man shall give as he is able, according to the blessing of the LORD thy God which he hath given thee (Deut 16:17)
- 8. Behold, they shall surely gather together, but not by me: whosoever shall gather together against thee shall fall for thy sake (Isaiah 54:15)

- 9. But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, which shines brighter and brighter until full day (Prov 4:18)
- 10. For thus saith the LORD; Like as I have brought all this great evil upon this people, so will I bring upon them all the good that I have promised them (Jeremiah 32:42)

- 11. There's none holy as the Lord: for there's none beside thee: neither is there any rock like our God (1 Sam 2:2)
- 12. The Lord is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower (Psalm 18: 2)
- 13. When a man's ways please the Lord, he maketh even his enemies to be at peace with him (Proverbs 16:7)
- 14. In righteousness shalt thou be established: thou shalt be far from oppression; for thou shalt not fear: and from terror; for it shall not come near thee (Isaiah 54:14)
- 15. Therefore I will look unto the Lord; I will wait for the God of my salvation: my God will hear me (Micah 7:7)
- 16. And I will strengthen them in the Lord; and they shall walk up and down in his name, saith the Lord (Zec 10:12)
- 17. If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it (John 14:14)
- 18. Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place (2 Corinthians 2:14)
- 19. But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil." (2 Thessalonians 3:3)
- 20. He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son (Revelation 21:7)

- 21. Thou shalt no more be termed Forsaken; neither shall thy land any more be termed desolate: but thou shalt be called Hephzibah, and thy land Beulah: for the Lord delighteth in thee and thy land shall be married (Isaiah 62:4)
- 22. The fear of the Lord tendeth to life; and he that hath it shall abide satisfied; he shall not be visited with evil (Proverbs 19:23)
- 23. For whether we live, we live unto the Lord; and whether we die, we die unto the Lord: whether we live therefore, or die, we are the Lord's (Romans 14:8)
- 24. The Lord thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; He will save, He will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in His love, He will joy over thee with singing (Zephaniah 3:17)
- 25. But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I am the LORD which exercise lovingkindness, judgement and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, saith the LORD (Jeremiah 9:24)
- 26. The eternal God is your refuge and underneath are the everlasting arms: and he shall thrust out the enemy from before thee; and shall say, Destroy them (Deuteronomy 33:27)
- 27. But God shall redeem my soul from the power of the grave; for He shall receive me. Selah (Psalm 49:15)
- 28. For he that toucheth you toucheth the apple of His eye (Zechariah 2:8b)
- 29. The Lord is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble; and He knoweth them that trust in Him (Nahum1:7)
- 30. Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth his conversation aright will I shew the salvation of God (Psalm 50:23)

For the LORD hath turned away the excellency of Jacob, as the excellency of Israel: for the emptiers have emptied them out, and marred their vine branches (Nahum 2:2)

- 31. Because thy loving kindness is better than life, my lip shall praise him (Psalm 63:3)
- 32. Though he slay me, yet will I trust him (Job 13:15)
- 33. But the people the people that know their God shall be strong and do exploits (Daniel 11:32b)
- 34. Blessed is the man that trusteth in the Lord, and whose hope the Lord is (Jer 17:7)
- 35. Daughter thy faith has made thee whole (Mark 5:34)
- 36. He must increase but I must decrease (John 3:30)
- 37. The Lord hath made all things for himself: yea, even the wicked for the day of evil (Proverbs 16: 4)
- 38. Is there anything too difficult for God? (Genesis 18:4)
- 39. This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shall meditate therein day and night (Joshua 1:8)
- 40. I will deliver thee out of the hand of the wicked, and I will redeem thee out of the hand of the terrible (Jer 15:21)

- 41. And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality (Colossians 2:10)
- 42. For thou wilt light my candle: The Lord my God will enlighten my darkness (Psalms 18:28)
- 43. This day is salvation come to this house, forsomuch as he also is a son of Abraham (Luke 19:9)
- 44. And he shall be unto thee a restorer of thy life, and a nourisher of thine old age (Ruth 4:15)
- 45. Thy shoes shall be iron and brass: and as thy days so shall thy strength be (Deuteronomy 33:25)

- 50. A land which the Lord thy God careth for: the eyes of the Lord thy God are always upon it from the beginning of the year even until the end of the year (Deuteronomy 11:12)

- 51. Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things (Philippians 4:8)

- 56. Hear; for I will speak of excellent things; and the opening of my lips shall be right things (Proverbs 8:6).
- 57. And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not" (Galatians 6:9).
- 58. But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you (1 Peter 5:10)
- 59. That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God (Colossians 1:10)
- 60. Come unto me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest (Matthew 11:28)

- 61. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? (Romans 8:35)
- 62. "For thou hast delivered my soul from death: wilt not thou deliver my feet from falling, that I may walk before God in the light of the living?" (Psalms 56:13)
- 63. And said these men, we shall not find any occasion against this Daniel, except we find it against him concerning the law of his God (Daniel 6:5)
- 64. That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him (Ephesians 1:17)
- 65. According to my earnest expectation and my hope, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death (Philippians 1:20)
- 66. Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness (Colossians 1:11)
- 67. "That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory." (1 Thessalonians 2:12)
- 68. "Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers." (Titus 1:9)
- 69. Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, let everyone that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity (2 Timothy 2:19)
- 70. God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will? (Hebrews 2:4)

- 71. And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them? (Lk 18:7)
- 72. For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost (Lk 19:10)
- 73. I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out (Lk 19:40)
- 74. How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! (Isaiah 14:12)
- 75. Truly in vain is salvation hoped for from the hills, and from the multitude of mountains: truly in the Lord our God is the salvation of Israel (Jeremiah 3:23)

- 76. For the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written (Romans 2:24)
- 77. Therefore thus will I do unto thee, O Israel: and because I will do this unto thee, prepare to meet thy God, O Israel (Amos 4:12)
