Suggested Prayer Points

1. Lord God, “thou art worthy, to receive glory, honor and power”, for making this Prayer-A-Thon possible
2. O Lord, we thank you in advance, for the great and glorious things that you will do and undo in this season
3. O Lord, “help us to lay aside every weight and sin which doth so easily beset us”, that we may not pray in vain
4. Lord, “death and life are in the power of the tongue”, therefore, I speak life, power and victory into this program
5. O Lord, consider and honor this program; let it be unto us as we have prayed and believed, in Jesus name
6. O Lord, I thank you for the” word of the Lord is perfect, for the converting and refreshing of my soul”
7. O Lord, I thank you for the “word of the Lord is sure”, for it has turn my foolishness into wisdom
8. O Lord, I thank you for the “statutes of the Lord are right”, for they bring joy into my heart daily
9. O Lord, I thank you for “the commandment of the Lord is pure”, for it has opened my eyes to spiritual powers
10. O Lord, come into my dreamscape and give me instructions, that I may be “withdrawn from any wrong purpose”
11. Lord, let my heart be a “good ground”, to receive your Word to “bring forth fruit, a hundredfold”, in Jesus name

12. O Lord may I never “add unto the word which you’ve commanded, nor shall I diminish ought from it”
13. Lord, I ask, not for my holiness or uprightness of my heart, let there be a performance of your spoken promises
14. Lord, as discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart may your word always convict me of my evil intent
15. O Lord, give ear to the words of my mouth: when fearfulness and trembling are come upon me, in Jesus name
16. O Lord, control my words, “for by my words I shalt be justified, and by my words shalt I be condemned”
17. O Lord, whenever I’m exhorting or ministering prevent me from employing “enticing words of man's wisdom”
18. Lord, I come against that wicked one, that comes to steal or corrupt the Word of God in my heart, in Jesus name
19. Lord, when doubt/fear creeps into my heart may your Spirit put me into remembrance of your declared Oracles
20. O Lord, you said, “ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free”, free me from all my bondage
21. O Lord, let thy word be exalted every day in my life, “for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name”
22. O Lord, at thy Word may I become more “fruitful, multiply, and subdue and have dominion over the earth”
23. O Lord, give me the grace to wait upon you in my affliction, till the Word of the Lord proves true in my situation
24. O Lord, touch and put your words in my mouth with power to pull down, destroy or throw down evil powers
25. Lord, help me to yield my life totally to the power of your word, that you may always be honored and glorified
26. Lord God, let your word as a Lamp be the divine wisdom in my life that comes from reading God’s Word
27. Lord God may your word as a Lamp shine powerfully in my life to dissolve every power of darkness around me
28. Lord, fulfil your word: “I will make my words in thy mouth fire, and the people wood, and it shall devour them”
29. O Lord, the words of God: “they are spirit, and they are life” may they quicken my soul to live for you alone
30. O Lord, help me to get rid of all immoralities in my life, and to humbly accept and practice the word of God
31. O Lord, forgive me for hypocrisy and self-deception for merely being a hearer and not a doer of the Word
32. O Lord, let your “Word like a hammer” break all unbroken areas of my life this year, in Jesus name
33. O Lord, let my mouth permanently be given to “soft answers that turn away wrath”, in the name of Jesus
34. O Lord, help my Spirit-Man to always resist “grievous words which stir up anger”, in the name of Jesus
35. O Lord, purge my heart of “evil treasure, for out of the abundance of the hearth the mouth speaketh”
36. Lord, help me to “study to show myself approved unto God, that I may rightly divide the word of life and truth”
37. Lord, my soul is athirst for thy glory and presence, therefore, O Lord, bid me to come unto thee, in Jesus name
38. O Lord, grant unto thy servant the keys to thy kingdom and reveal the hidden mysteries in thy Word
39. O Lord, as I pray now, give me the grace to speak the Word of God with boldness and power, in Jesus name
40. O Lord, silence and condemn every destructive tongue or words of the wicked that rise up against me
41. O Lord, fashion my tongue to be a righteous tongue that speaks life and health into the darkened souls of men
42. O “Lord, to whom shall we go”? Therefore, we run unto thee, for “Thou hast the words of eternal life... for we are not of them who draw back unto perdition” or condemnation, in the name of Jesus

43. O Lord, I reject ever “making the word of God of none effect [in my life] through human tradition”
44. O Lord, by your mercy, grant me abundant grace to be able to present the word of God in its fullness
45. Lord God, I declare “Peace, be still” upon my soul, while I’m being delivered from all my fears and anxieties
46. O Lord, you said, “let there be light: and there was light”; O Lord, by the same voice speak healing upon my life
47. O Lord, let the power in your word dissolve and consume any area of my life that there’s “void or darkness”
48. O Lord, I declare “Ephphatha, that is, be opened” to all closed doors against my life, ministry and destiny
49. O Lord, “Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee, in the name of Jesus”
50. Lord, “Thy word have I hid in mine heart, for it is my desire and delight to do your will”, in the name of Jesus
51. O Lord, I declare, “the grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand forever” in my life
52. O Lord, in this season of prayer may you send Zion a word, that we may be strengthened and comforted
53. O Lord may every word that you send never return to you empty, but achieve the purpose for which it is sent
54. O Lord, let the sanctifying and cleansing power of thy word be evident in my life and character, in Jesus name
55. Lord God, as I read and meditate upon your Word may it be health unto my life, and unto my soul and body
56. Lord God, by the Spirit and Life of the word of God, I command the spirit of untimely death to pass me over
57. O Lord, Ezekiel spoke to the dry bones and they came alive, by the same Spirit I speak life into my vital organs
58. O Lord may my faith in your Word as a healing “Balm” always prosper my life and health, in the name of Jesus
59. O Lord may your word always promote love and harmony among us as your disciples, in the name of Jesus
60. Lord God, as I read and meditate upon your word may it restore unto me hope, peace and the joy of the Lord
61. O Lord may I never let any situation to diminish the assuring and comforting power of the word of God
62. O Lord, command our healings and deliverances, for by thy word “we live, and move, and have our being”
63. O Lord may no prophecy in our church ever come by the will of man but by the inspiration of the Holy Ghost
64. O Lord, your word is likened unto seeds, therefore, make Zion bountiful seed sowers and reapers, in Jesus name
65. Lord, by the agency of thy word, reveal to me my hidden bondage and lawful captivity, in the name of Jesus
66. Lord, help us to repent and mourn when your word uncovers and lays bare before our eyes sin in our lives
67. O Lord, let your word be my principal counsellor, and deliver me from being wise in my own eyes
68. O Lord, as I strive to fully obey your word may none of the curses in Deuteronomy 28 come upon me
69. O Lord, I cast down vain imaginations that could cause me to open my mouth to speak foolishly, in Jesus name
70. O Lord, perform miracles among us when your word is preached, and our voices lifted up to pray and praise you
71. O Lord, bestow abundant grace and faith upon me, as “faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God”
72. O Lord, let the word of God dwell richly in me, that I may be thoroughly equipped for a pattern of good work
73. O Lord, the bible says, “affliction shall not rise the second time”, therefore, every conquered affliction in my life and body, “hear ye the word of the Lord”: be gone and I shall experience you no more, in the name of Jesus

75. O Lord, “a day in thy courts is better than a thousand” elsewhere, but let my words be few before thee
76. O Lord, help me to be “quick to hear but slow to speak”, that I may not sin against thee, in the name of Jesus
77. O Lord, let me never speak without knowledge nor without wisdom, in the name of Jesus
78. O Lord may I not be “snared or be taken with the words of my mouth”, in the name of Jesus
79. Lord, “the simple believeth every word: but the prudent man looketh well to his going”; guard my ears, O Lord
80. O Lord, “a man hath joy by the answer of his mouth: and a word spoken in due season, how good is it”!
81. Lord God, “the words of the wicked engender strife but the mouth of the righteous speaks peace”
82. O Lord, “The words of a talebearer are as wounds”; may I never start any rumors nor gossips, in Jesus name
83. O Lord, help me to “cease to hear the instruction that causeth to err from the words of knowledge” or wisdom
84. Lord God may every contrary word vowed or spoken into my life, fall to the ground and be nullified now
85. O Lord, “let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth”, in the name of Jesus
86. O Lord may you turn every spoken curse against me into blessing, in the name of Jesus
87. O Lord, by the righteousness of God, I come against all inherited curses disturbing or hindering my life
88. O Lord, let the voice of Jesus’ blood cry out for my deliverance from all hidden bondage that I’m made to serve
89. O Lord, in the multitude of counsels, grant me the discernment to only hearken to the voice that’s from on High
90. O Lord, as I obey your voice, and keep your commandments may I be a blessing to the body of Christ
91. O Lord, let your “still small voice” always speak louder and powerfully to drown-out satanic voices in my head
92. O Lord, I bind and rebuke demons that sometimes twist or corrupt my voice and words, in the name of Jesus
93. O Lord, silence every evil voice lifted up to cry or lament falsely against Zion, individually or collectively
94. O Lord, let no curse words proceed out of my mouth, but that which is good and edifying unto my hearers
95. O Lord, you said “I will be with thy mouth, and will teach you what ye shall do”; may that be unto me forever
96. O Lord, I silence and cast out any lying spirit in my mouth; let my yeah be yeah and nay be nay, in Jesus name
97. O Lord, I consecrate my mouth unto you, and may I never use my mouth to bear false witness against anyone
98. Lord, “I will sing of the mercies of the LORD forever: with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all”
99. O Lord, as a Just God, plead my cause and open thy mouth and judge righteously between my enemy and I
100. O Lord, by your mercy, be not angry at my voice, “let it be a sweet, sweet sound in your ears”, in Jesus name
101. O Lord, help me to tone down my emotions in my conversations with people, in the name of Jesus
102. O Lord, as I speak your word, convict the people to repent with godly sorrow and resist the temptations to sin
103. O Lord, purge my tongue, for “the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison”
104. Lord God, I pray, let “the words of my mouth be in righteousness; and nothing froward or perverse in them”
105. O Lord, in handling thy Word may I show integrity, seriousness and soundness in my exhortations that cannot be condemned or opposed, in the name of JESUS. Amen
