

Lamentations for Zion, City of David

...Prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God

(Acts 12:5)

1. Lord, receive our prayer today, as we cry: holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come
2. O Lord, “nothing in our hands we bring, but simply to thy cross we cling”, pleading for thy pity or mercy today

8. O Lord, you’re “the way, and the truth”, therefore, lead us in all truths, wisdom and knowledge of your ways
9. O Lord may your Spirit always come as ‘a rushing mighty wind’ to announce your presence in our meetings
10. O Lord, “without faith it is impossible to please God”, therefore, Lord God, “help thou [our] unbelief” in Zion
11. O Lord, by thy grace and mercy, deliver Zion from the forces of darkness that’re warring against her existence
12. O Lord, send us sincere seekers, and cause them to abide and become active-fruitful Zion disciples
13. O Lord, keep time wasters, energy suckers and fake seekers far away from Zion, within and without
14. O Lord, send us seekers that’ll not resist the expediency of the gospel and the holy ghost upon their hearts
15. O Lord, frustrate any manipulation of the enemy to make Zion a reproach to our landlord, in the name of Jesus
16. O Lord, perform wonders in Zion, that’ll cause wide-eyed and tingle ears as in Lystra, to draw men unto you
17. O Lord, destroy horns that’re holding down Zion, and not allowing it to advance and flourish in this generation
18. Lord, help and guide the shepherd of Zion to always show integrity and divine wisdom in managing your house
19. Lord, let this generation come to know Zion, as a city where the Holy Bible is the final authority in all matters
20. O Lord, as the Master Builder, we beseech thee to arise, build and lift Zion unto a new level of prominence
21. O Lord, destroy any power, throne and principality that’re limiting or hindering Zion’s numerical strength
22. O Lord, frustrate any attempt and effort by any establishment wanting to take advantage of Zion financially

31. O Lord, let no dispute ever rise up between Zion and the Landlord or the property manager, in Jesus name
32. O Lord, touch the Landlord or the property manager's heart to always do the right thing unto Zion
33. O Lord, do something powerful at our location for the Landlord to know that you're alive in the Castle of Zion
34. O Lord, arise and destroy the powers of darkness assigned to discourage and hinder Zion's divine helpers
35. Lord, as the evil confederacy stretch forth their hand against Zion may our God cut them off, in Jesus name
36. O Lord, let any agent of mockery or scorner sent to despise Zion, be turned back by the whirlwind of God

56. O Lord, let the evil tongue of Zion's critics and mockers be condemned and silenced permanently, in Jesus name
57. Lord, always release your Word to come forth in Zion with fire and power to expose emptiness and pride in men
58. O Lord, we reject scandals, big or small, that could tarnish and diminish the glorious name and image of Zion
59. O Lord, raise among us men and women faithfully committed to the true gospel, to pierce this present darkness

82. Lord, help us to continually "grow in grace" in every area of our lives, to your glory and honor, in Jesus name
83. O Lord, help us to make it our duty to see to it that we're not a stumbling block to our pastor nor to one another
84. Lord, do not cut off our expectation to see healings, deliverances and character changes in all of Zion's programs
85. Lord God, we soberly bring Zion's finances into your inexhaustible storehouse for your divine multiplication
86. O Lord, reverse any witchcraft manipulations and curses that're affecting Zion's recognition and growth pattern

93. Lord may "everything that has breath" that walks into the Castle of Zion be stripped of their pride and arrogance
94. O Lord, loose the tongue and lips of "everything that has breath", that comes into your presence in the Castle of Zion, and make them to open their mouths to pray, praise and worship you, in the name of Jesus.

95. O Lord, let not the enemy cause us to cease to “be of the same [sincere and kind] mind one toward another”
96. O Lord, make Zion a city highly favored and graciously endowed with divers spiritual gifts, in the name of Jesus
97. O Lord may we always in a singleness of heart reject every act of immorality or wickedness, within and without
98. Lord, let Zion be a Castle where the wicked shall come to forsake his ways and thoughts, and turn unto the Lord
99. O Lord, help our guests to marvel and appreciate the miracle of praying aloud in heavenly languages in Zion
100. O Lord, always lay upon us monthly divine issues and the burdens to fast and pray fervently for or against them
101. O Lord, we condemn and cast down every tongue that has risen up in judgement against Zion, in Jesus name

119. O Lord, cast asunder evil powers that does not want to see Zion prosper spiritually, numerically and financially

121. O Lord, “Thou shalt arise, and have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favor Zion, yea, the set time, is come”
122. O Lord, arise, “roll back [any evil] stone from the door” at Castle of Zion that hinders future Zion co-disciples
123. O Lord, let none of our first-time guests ever have a bad ‘first impression’ of Zion as a castle of godliness
124. O Lord, as ministries are being cast down may we declare, “there is a lifting up” in Zion, in Jesus name
125. O Lord, let every foul spirit that works through co-disciples to disrupt our meetings, be checked at the door
126. O Lord, we reject and cast out the plague and spirit of the nine ungrateful lepers from Zion, in Jesus name

127. O Lord, lead us and open our eyes to know what you desire for Zion to become in the body of Christ

128. O Lord, grant us discernment to corporately see all of our transgressions (small or big) against you

129. O Lord may you send multitude of all nations, kindreds and tongues to come and worship before you in Zion

130. Lord, to you be the glory, honor and thanksgiving for bringing us out of our Egypt (comfort zone at Landmark)

131. Lord God may our new rent never become a giant in our eyes, for we walk by faith and not by sight

147. Lord God may Zion continually be at your disposal for all the business of your kingdom, in Jesus name

148. O Lord, in doing our duties unto you, help us to be detached from the influence of the flesh and of the world

174. O Lord, by your spirit quicken our visitors or new comers to discern within them that Jesus is alive in Zion

175. O Lord, make Zion disciples cheerful and bountiful givers, and selfless workers in your house, in Jesus name

176. Lord, let your proclaimed word in Zion enlighten the ignorant, awaken the dead and encourage the downcast

177. O Lord, let every man or woman that comes to Zion revel in your presence and be touched by your free Spirit

178. O Lord, arise and scatter any power that is beclouding, hindering or delaying your purpose for Zion

179. O Lord may any evil determined or purposed against Zion be nullified, overthrown and backfire, in Jesus name

180. O Lord, raise divine carpenters to 'fray and cast out the horns of the wicked which lift up their horns over' Zion

181. O Lord, for thy name sake may nothing negative ever rise up in Zion to bring about evil or negative publicity

182. O Lord may only miracles, signs and wonders bring Zion into the limelight, in the name of Jesus

183. O Lord, let not Zion's "good [deeds] be evil spoken of"; rather let the people always remember to glorify you

184. O Lord, come and 'be unto [Zion] a wall of fire round about, and be the glory in midst of her", in Jesus name

185. O Lord may the fire in Zion never be without wood; Lord, supply us the collective zeal to keep the fire burning

186. O Lord may you instantly put out any attempt of 'strange fire' rising up or being offered in the Castle of Zion

187. O Lord, we come against demonic forces that push or lure ministries into error and disgrace, in Jesus name

188. Lord, let your Fire always burn too hot in Zion for any arrogant, prideful or hardened sinner to be comfortable

189. O Lord, draw many who worship unknown gods to come to Zion, to meet and know the only True God

190. Lord, for thy name sake, let "men know that thou, whose name alone is JEHOVAH [reigns as] the Most-High" in Zion, City of David
