Through God we shall do valiantly: for he it is that shall tread down our enemies

(Psalm 108:13)

4. O Lord, we decree, Christ shall be magnified in Zion always, whether it be by fire or by a still small voice
5. O Lord may you that bare the sins and make intercession for transgressions of men, purge us of all our sins
6. O Lord, we bless and glorify you that we now know you, for we once were ignorant of your truth and majesty
7. O Lord may you always sift Zion’s disciples like Gideon’s army to expose insincerity and hypocrisy among us
8. O Lord, with our new financial obligations may you show yourself as our Jehovah Jireh, our provider
9. O Lord, give us a heart like our father Abraham who did not withhold his only son Isaac from the Lord
10. Lord God, let the hand of the Lord be upon Zion that we may always outrun, overtake and outlast our enemies
11. O Lord may the purpose for which you established Zion never be cut off or defeated by any demonic forces
12. Lord God, we collectively break and curse all the powers of darkness and their evil assignments against Zion
13. O Lord, open all the doors of favor unto Zion for your purpose and glory, and close all the doors that are not
14. O Lord, reveal to us what is right and wrong for Zion, and what is right and wrong with Zion, in Jesus name
15. Lord God, we plead and overcome by the blood of Jesus all the tricks, plots and traps of the enemy against Zion
16. O Lord, as we seek your face monthly, do not hide yourself from us, for our desire is for you to possess us
17. O Lord, break and deliver Zion from any latent or active foul spirit of Ananias and Sapphira, in Jesus name
18. O Lord, break and deliver Zion from the curse of financial disloyalty, distrust and false suspicion
19. Lord God, bring us disciples that would heed your clarion call of “freely have ye received, freely give”
20. O Lord may you convict and rebuke every wicked tongue of the ungrateful Zion’s critics, in Jesus name
21. O Lord, as you multiplied 5 loaves to feed 5,000 may you multiply Zion’s storehouse to meet all our needs
22. O Lord God of Jabez, make Zion to be “more honorable” among other ministries, in the name of Jesus
23. O Lord God of Jabez, we call upon “the God of Israel, saying, oh that thou wouldest bless [us] indeed”
24. O Lord God of Jabez, we call upon “the God of Israel, saying, oh that thou wouldest enlarge our [outreach]”
25. O Lord God of Jabez, we call upon “the God of Israel, saying, oh that thine hand might be with [Zion]”
26. O Lord God of Jabez, we call upon “the God of Israel, saying, oh that thou wouldest keep [Zion] from evil”
27. Lord, the bible says, “and God granted [Jabez] that which he requested”; may you also grant all Zion’s requests
28. O breath of God of Ezekiel, come from the 4 winds, breathe upon Zion, that we may be revived, healed and live
29. O God of Ezekiel, make us a great army that will stand upon our feet financially, spiritually and physically

30. O Lord, perform this scripture in Zion: “Examine yourselves, whether ye be in faith; prove your own selves”
31. O Lord, help Zion disciples who are stuck, and whose belly are only flowing ankle-deep rivers of living water
32. O Lord may [violence, devastation or destruction never be heard within the borders] of Zion, City of David
33. O Lord, fulfil our desire to make Zion “walls of salvation, and our gates praise” for all of God’s people
34. O Lord, let the cry of the wicked to their gods against Zion be of no consequences to our lives and destinies
35. O Lord, as your feeble sheep, help Zion to always do all things “at thy word” like Peter, in the name of Jesus
36. O Lord, arise, “hold not thy peace, O God for the [evil] mouths of the wicked are opened against” Zion
37. O Lord, hold not thy peace, O God, judge all those that have rewarded Zion evil for good, in the name of Jesus
38. O Lord, spare Zion individually and collectively of the bad news that could make us “heavy and displeased”
39. O Lord may we never be lulled to sleep and complacent after any spiritual victory or breakthrough
40. O Lord, let our enemies know that you’ll fight for us on the mountains, in the valleys, on the land and in the sea
41. Lord, Zion might be numbered like ‘two little flocks of goats’, but Lord, always give us victory over a multitude
42. O Lord, when the enemy comes in like a flood may we never play dead; quicken us to rebuke and resist him
43. O Lord, as you bring us into the City of David, help us not to make any evil covenant with the devil or his agents
44. Lord, by your mercy and our prayers, grant us respite from the consequences of our errors and demonic attacks
45. O Lord may none in Zion be guilty of contributing to the evil that’s going on in our society today and beyond
46. O Lord, by your mercy the scripture: “strike the shepherd and the flock will scatter” shall never be unto Zion
47. O Lord, continually mold our leaders to be blameless, vigilant, sober, considerate, patient and apt to do good
48. O Lord, as you continually feed Zion with the Bread of Life may you feed our enemies with bread of affliction
49. Lord, make Zion an unending fountain of the Living Water and never a fountain of water of affliction/bitterness
50. Lord, who’s heard or seen such a thing: a nation being born in one day, yet you’ll make Zion an instant Praise
51. O Lord, shall you bring Zion out of the wilderness and cut us off? Arise, Lord, finish what you’ve started with us
52. O Lord, in these last days, make Zion your battle axe and weapon of war to break in pieces kingdom of darkness
53. O Lord, two things we require of thee: [let us not be ashamed and let not our enemies triumph over us]
54. O Lord, remove far from Zion, “having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof”, in Jesus name
55. Lord, by your wisdom give Zion neither very few nor very large disciples, but give us what is convenient for us
56. O Lord, “the churning of milk bringeth forth butter”, hence, let the churning of our prayer lives bring results
57. Lord, for thy name sake, let “men know that thou, whose name alone is JEHOVAH” reigns mightily in Zion
58. Lord God, help us to reject and overcome powers bewitching us to be intolerant and prejudice, in Jesus name

60. O Lord, rebuke the natural men and women that speak evil of those things which they know not concerning Zion
