7. O Lord, we can never thank you enough for bringing Zion City of David out of the wilderness and obscurity
8. O Lord, we thank you for the joy and peace that you gave us during life in the wilderness for many months
9. Lord, as we always come to you in defiled garments of sin may you never fail to grant us change of raiment
10. Lord God may we in Zion never lose sight of the exceeding greatness, power and might of your love in our lives
11. O Lord, as The Everlasting Father, come and take over the government of Zion and let your Will rule forever
12. Lord God, cut off and dry up any hidden fountain of pollution that is flowing in Zion City of David
13. O Lord, deliver Zion from the false god of SELF (self-worship, self-centeredness, self-will & self-righteousness)
14. O Lord, deliver us individually from a no-man’s-land of vain and vile imaginations and thoughts, in Jesus name
15. Lord God, give us no rest nor peace until we overcome our frequent and secret sins, in the name of Jesus

20. Lord, destroy the power of darkness in Zion whose hidden presence causes distrust and false suspicion among us
21. Lord, as thy people come to Zion, reveal to them the wounds and scars of sin for them to detest and flee from sin
22. O Lord, help us never to mistake the excitement of our passion for the working power of the Holy Ghost in us
23. O Lord, for as the deer pants for streams of water, so our souls desperately seek a touch from our Master
24. O Lord, as we strive to mature spiritually, help us to be consecrated wholly to you and live entirely to your glory

25. O Lord, by your tender mercies may you clear away anything hindering the manifestations of gifts in Zion
26. O Lord, in all our meetings, at the mention of your name may every evil power and unclean spirits bow
27. O Lord, in every of our gatherings, make it known that we worship you alone, the only True God of Israel
28. O Lord, whenever an adversary rises up to disrupt our meetings, let the angel of the Lord slay them in the spirit
29. O Lord, in your holy jealousy, expose and arrest any man or woman that's determined evil against Zion
30. O Lord, destroy any calendar of the wicked that has our name as their next target, victim, casualty or prey
31. O Lord, you made the bitter waters of Mara sweet; may you make any bitter heart in Zion sweet and loving
32. O Lord, in our quest and desire to attain more brokenness, cause us to grieve and abhor every known guile in us
33. O Lord, frustrate and overturn whatever be the evil plan of the enemy against our new Castle of Zion
34. O Lord, as the mountains are round about Jerusalem may the Lord be round about Zion with his holy angels
35. O Lord, 'turn again the captivity of Zion, that our mouths be filled with laughter and singing' unto you
36. O Lord may we not miss nor forget all the lessons that you desired to teach us in the wilderness, in Jesus name
37. O Lord, "except the Lord build the house, they labor in vain" therefore, Lord, come and build and dwell in Zion
38. O Lord, have mercy upon us, and let it not be in vain that we fast, rise up early or stay up late to pray unto you
39. O Lord, it's not in us to help ourselves, so, Lord, we lift up our eyes unto thy Hills from whence cometh our help

44. Lord God, help us to have supreme regard for others, and in meekness let us esteem others better than ourselves
45. O Lord, naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return, so, Lord make us pilgrims on earth
46. O Lord, "the Lord gave, and the Lord hath taken away;" therefore, Lord, all that I have or own I surrender to you
47. O Lord, let there be a great flow of the Spirit of Jesus in Zion, that we may all be about our Father's business
48. O Lord, you're the giver of every perfect gift, therefore, Lord, let there be an explosion of spiritual gifts in Zion
49. Lord, give us the power and authority that we may boldly demolish worldly strongholds of conspiracies and lies
50. O Lord, deliver us individually from our worldly passions, self-serving compromises and gratifications
51. O Lord, 'help thou our unbelief', that we may always trust you in every trial, dark days or amidst life's changes
52. O Lord, may none come to Zion for earthly riches, but to be numbered with the spiritually delivered and blessed
